School Profile:

Job Description:

Under the supervision of the School Principal, the **Speech & Language Pathologist** provides instruction and services for those students whose needs have been identified in an individualized education program developed by the individualized education program team and who are assigned to regular classroom teachers for most of a school day.

Essential Duties:

- Provides LAS services to students on a one-to-one or small group basis.
- Coordinates special education services with the regular school programs for each student with special needs enrolled.
- Monitors student progress on a regular basis, participating in the development, review and revision of IEP goals.
- Administers speech and language standardized and informal assessments.
- Writes the LAS reports at all initial and re-evaluation IEPS.
- Provides consultation, resource information and material regarding individuals with special needs to their parents and to regular staff members.
- Consults with parents and general education classroom teacher regarding students who have LAS services.
- Supports the policies and programs of the LAUSD/NEW Academy district and perform assigned duties consistent with school, District and Special Education policies, regulations, and procedures.
- Provides Professional Development on a variety of special education topics.
- Creates and maintains Individualized Education Program (IEP) records on the LAUSD Welligent Database.
- Other duties as assigned by Supervisor.







Requirements:

- Possess valid Speech-Language Pathology Service Credential
- Bi-lingual (Spanish & English) requires.
- Minimum 2 years experience and/or at least two years of professional training and/or experience with special education students.
- Must be Welligent proficient or similar data base and have knowledge of an IEP process.
- Clearance with the Department of Justice via live scan
- Proof and clearance of TB test (current within 60 days)

Salary Rate: starting rate \$85,000.00 - 90,000.00.
